

This guideline provides a standard compliment of response maps, guidebooks, and special forms to be carried on all North Zone apparatus and staff vehicles. Response maps, guidebooks, and special forms are designed to aid personnel during emergency operations and non-emergency business. They are an integral part of a safe incident response and efficient scene management. It is the responsibility of the apparatus and/or vehicle operator to insure this compliment is maintained. Company Officers shall emphasize the importance of regular inventory checks with assigned personnel.

All North Zone apparatus and staff vehicles equipped for emergency response shall carry the following response maps and guidebooks:

- Unit Directory
- Agency Run Map
- Special Area Maps
- San Diego County Thomas Brothers
- California Road Atlas
- Preplan Books, Structure and Wildland
- DOT North American Emergency Response Guidebook
- NIOSH Pocket Guide
- Resource Directory
- FOG (Field Operations Guide)

In addition to the above list, ambulances may carry run maps for neighboring jurisdictions.

All North Zone apparatus and staff vehicles equipped for emergency response shall carry the following special forms:

Staff vehicles equipped for emergency response may carry a greater quantity of the special forms listed and/or carry other special forms, as needed. This shall be based upon the job responsibilities of personnel assigned to each vehicle.

Staff vehicles not equipped for emergency response will carry, at a minimum, all special forms listed under Administration.
